STUDIO SPACES

We have a range of studio options and are one of the few precincts in Auckland to offer access to 'messy' workshops suitable for ceramicists, sculptors and object makers. We also offer a number of open studio spaces that can be hired individually or collectively for making, meetings, workshops or temporary events.

We are located in the heart of central Auckland with free wi-fi, kitchen facilities and the possibility for 24-hour access. Contact us to find out how we can support you.

THE CELL BLOCK

The Cell Block studio spaces are private studios. Each studio comes with 24-hour access and is hired on a monthly basis.

VILLA STUDIO

A shared studio space with access to the sculpture workshop is available. It comes with 24-hour access and is hired on a monthly basis.

WORKSHOP HIRE

'Niu', the Samoan word for coconut (a derogatory term for Pasifika people), pronounced like 'new' suggests a fresh beginning.

Naomi's vessels embody a poetic transformation, akin to a plantation striving for photosynthesis before being halted by the kiln's fire, fossilising the clay, and capturing specific moods in so. Her ceramic installations, reflect the turbulence of living in a rainy central city district and the tensions of navigating well-being in such an environment. Her art, inspired by her indulgences in horror and science fiction, merges natural processes with human intervention, embodying both physical and emotional landscapes.
